Guidelines for Recording Juvenile Matches.

- 1. Coaches must inform the club Secretary and the club Children's Officer of their intention to record the match.
- 2. Coaches must make contact with the opposing team's management and inform them of their intention to record the match. The coaches from the opposing team are also advised to inform their own club Secretary and Children's Officer.
- 3. The coaches of both teams must inform the parents of both teams of their intention to record the match. **Permission must be granted by all** parents, before this can go ahead.
- 4. Coaches must also through the club Secretary inform the County Secretary, CCC and the County Children's Officer.
- 5. If all permissions are sought and granted, the club Secretaries, Children Officers and the County officials informed and are in agreement, the match can then be recorded.
- 6. Once recorded all unedited footage must be made available to the opposing team.
